- Preference will be given to person with interest and/or experience in working on the inter-connectedness of climate change with public health
- Demonstrated experience working with government departments and/or UN agencies.
- Familiarity with national and state climate and health frameworks, including NPCCHH and SAPCCs, is desirable.

- Contribute to technical reports, policy briefs, and presentations to support evidence-based decision-making at state and district levels.
- Support the establishment and operationalization of the State level Centre for Climate Change and Human Health (CCCHH).
- Undertake any other task required to achieve the desired output.
