# 2. Capacity building for FSSM with NIUA under Sanitation Capacity Building Platform (October 2018 – March 2019)

#### Three days training cum exposure visit programme on FSSM for ULB officials from various states

AIILSG Mumbai has partnered with NIUA, Delhi for capacity building on FSSM for selected ULBs, under Sanitation Capacity Building Platform, supported by Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. A systematic effort has been made to develop a training module for three days training programme on FSSM, including site visits to best practices. AIILSG, Mumbai is a part of the Training Module Review Committee (TMRC), formed under the SCBP at NIUA and anchors the module for this three days training programme cum exposure visit. The module have been developed and reviewed by the TMRC through rounds of consultations and meetings. Based on the module, AIILSG Mumbai undertook the following activities:

- Conducted two training and exposure visits in Pune, Maharashtra with visit to Wai
- Conducted two training and exposure visits in Bhubaneswar and Puri in Odisha
- Conducted a national workshop on non-networked sanitation systems for India in Mussoorie, Uttarakhand

Three day training workshops were conducted for engineers, city and state officials, AMRUT nodal agencies and professionals associated with the government. The objective of these trainings was to develop a comprehensive understanding of the various components of FSSM to implement effective and sustainable sanitation solutions in cities through hands-on experience of a case study.

Four such trainings were successfully completed in 2018-19. Training programmes were appreciated and found useful in scaling up FSSM activities in respective States and ULBs
